

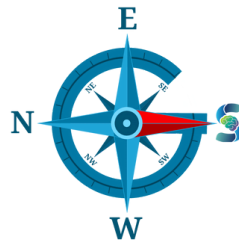

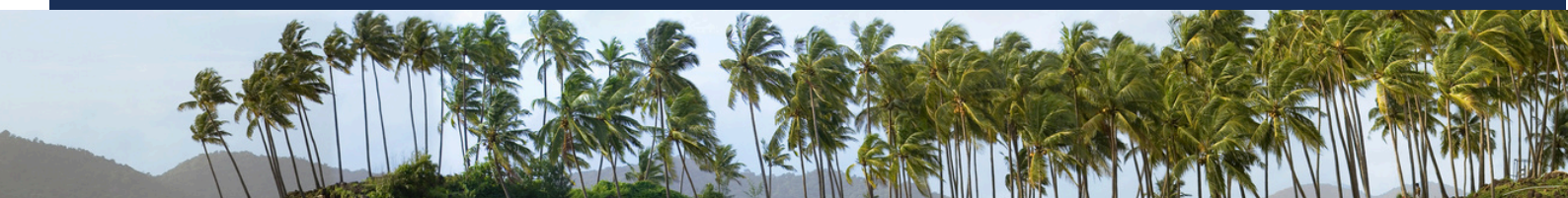

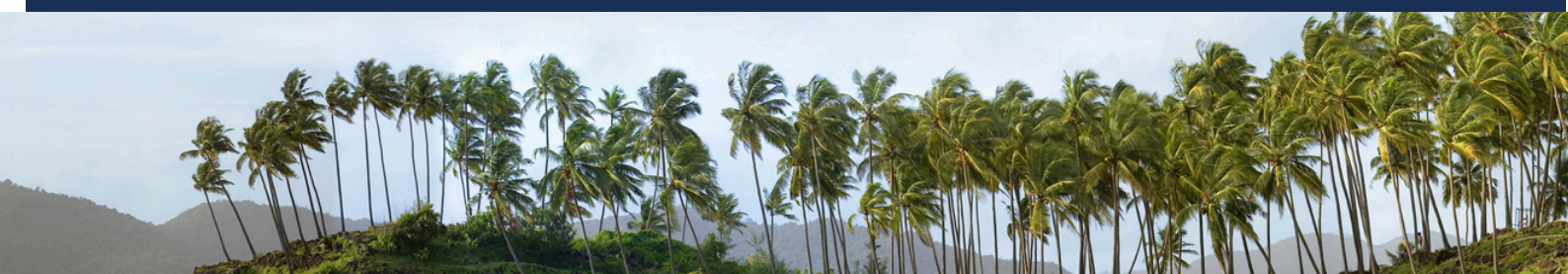

Simply infuse your creation with magic and send it to us, accompanied by a missive of introduction.

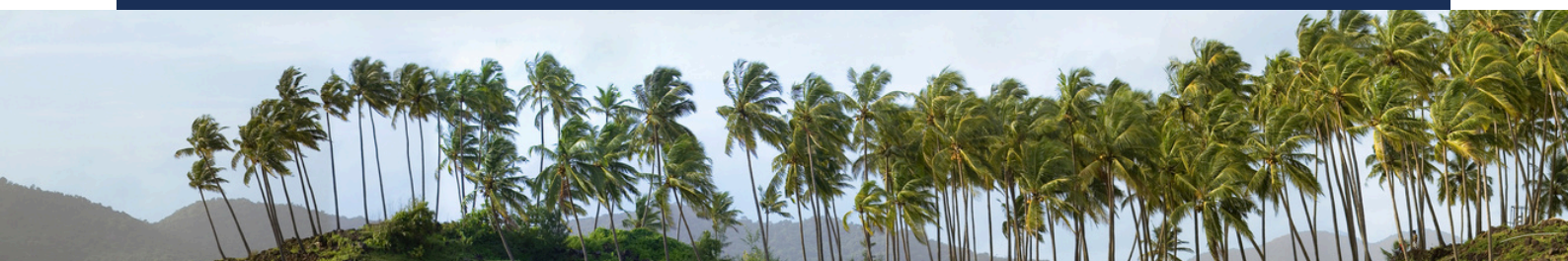
## *Format of Submission*

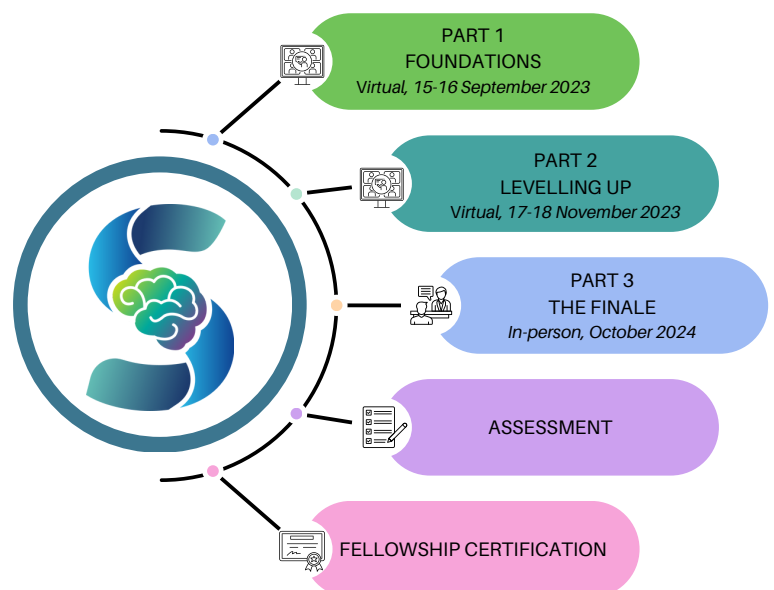
